**B. PROPOSAL**


1. Remove and replace pages P-6 through P-9 dated 08/20/14 with the attached pages P-6 through P-10 dated 12/21/16.

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## **PREFERENCES**

Bidders agree that preferences shall be taken into consideration to determine the low bidder in accordance with said Sections and the rules promulgated, however, the award of contract will be in the amount of the bid offered exclusive of any preferences.

### **A. HAWAII PRODUCTS PREFERENCE**

It is understood that certain Hawaii Products may be acceptable for use in this project and that, pursuant to Sections 103D-1002, HRS, which provides preference for Hawaii Products, a bidder proposing to use such Hawaii products shall so designate in the schedule provided below.

If a bidder proposes to use Hawaii Products, the bidder must so designate in said schedule by entering the cost of such product in the appropriate space provided. Failure on the part of the bidder to designate the use of Hawaii products will automatically void any preference for that product.

Persons desiring to qualify product(s) not currently on the list, shall complete form SPO-38, *Certification for Hawaii Product Preference* in accordance with the Special Provisions of these specifications.

It is understood by the bidder that if the bidder elects to furnish qualified Hawaii Products, and is awarded the contract, then fails to use such products or meet the requirements of such preference, the bidder shall be subject to the statutory penalties, provided in Section 103D-1002, Hawaii Revised Statute, and such other remedies as may be available to the State.

### **B. APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMS PREFERENCE**

**PRE-BID MEETING MINUTES  
JANUARY 10, 2017**

The following minutes are from the Hawaii Department of Transportation (HDOT) pre-bid meeting with prospective bidders for the Kalanianaole Highway Drainage Improvements, Vicinity of Wailupe Place project.

The meeting was held at Kakuhihewa Building in Kapolei, Room 611 at 9:00 AM.

A sign-in sheet with the names of the attendees is attached.

HDOT reminded the attendees that anything said at the meeting was for clarification only, and the bid documents shall govern over anything said at the meeting and discrepancies shall be clarified by addendum.

HDOT briefly discussed the proposed project and the scope of work. HDOT informed the attendees that this project does not require an NPDES permit.

Questions:

1. Can the work at the intersection of Kalanianaole Highway and West Hind Drive be done during night time? (HDOT responded that it will check on this matter, and the response will be included in Addendum No. 1)

**Response: HDOT will not allow night time work.**

2. Is there a specified Notice to Proceed date?

**Response: No, the bid documents do not specify a Notice to Proceed date. However, award of the construction contract is typically required within 60 days of the bid opening. HDOT indicated that this is a high priority project.**

3. Is there a soils report available for this project?

**Response: No, there is no soils report prepared for the project.**

HDOT reminded the attendees to submit any questions via email to the Project Manager shown on page P-1 of the Special Provisions no later than January 18, 2017.

All items discussed at this meeting will be reflected in Addendum No. 1.

The meeting ended at 9:20 AM.
