




WAIMANALO STREAM BRIDGE TO KUMUHAU ST.




KUMUHAU ST. TO KAHAWAI STREAM BRIDGE





KAHAWAI STREAM BRIDGE TO PAOLIMA ST.


THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUC-

UTILITY NOTES

- 1. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE BWS AND THE DIVISION OF WASTEWATER MANAGEMENT IN WRITING ONE WEEK PRIOR TO COMMENCING WORK ON THEIR FACILITIES.
- 2. UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED, ALL MATERIALS AND CONSTRUC-TION OF WATER SYSTEM FACILITIES AND APPURTENANCES SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE HONOLULU BOARD OF WATER SUPPLY'S WATER SYSTEM STANDARDS, DATED MARCH 1977, AND ALL SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS AND ADDITIONS.
- REAPPROVAL SHALL BE REQUIRED IF THIS PROJECT IS NOT UNDER CONSTRUCTION WITHIN A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR. (SEE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE BOARD OF WATER SUPPLY.)
- 4. PRIOR TO EXCAVATING FOR THE NEW A.C. PAVEMENT AND WHEELCHAIR RAMPS, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY IN THE FIELD THE LOCATION OF EXISTING UTILITIES AND APPURTE-
- 5. THE EXISTENCE AND LOCATION OF UNDERGROUND UTILITY FACILITIES AS SHOWN ON THE PLANS ARE FROM THE LATEST AVAILABLE DATA BUT ARE NOT GUARANTEED AS TO THE ACCU-RACY OR THE ENCOUNTERING OF OTHER OBSTACLES DURING THE COURSE OF THE WORK. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONS-IBLE AND SHALL PAY FOR ALL DAMAGES TO EXISTING UTILI-TIES, UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED.
- ALL PLANS APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF WATER SUPPLY AND THE DIVISION OF WASTEWATER MANAGEMENT ARE BASED SOLELY ON THE ADEQUACY OF THE WATER AND SEWER SYSTEMS.
- 7. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL RELOCATE OR ADJUST EXISTING METERS. METER BOXES, AND MANHOLES, INCLUDING FRAME AND COVER, IF FOUND NECESSARY.
- 8. ALL UNDERGROUND LINES IN THE AREA (TRAFFIC SIGNAL, STREET LIGHT, AND FIRE ALARM) ARE APPROXIMATELY 18 INCHES BELOW GROUND LEVEL AND SHALL BE KEPT OPERA-TIONAL DURING CONSTRUCTION. RELOCATIONS, IF NECESSARY. SHALL BE APPROVED BY THE ELECTRICAL AND MAINTENANCE DIVISION, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES, PHONE: 523-4905.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE JOINT POLE COMMITTEE TWO (2) WEEKS IN ADVANCE FOR ANY UTILITY POLE RELOCA-TION THAT MAY BE NECESSARY, PHONE: 548-5655.

GRADING NOTES

- 1. ALL GRADING WORK SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 23, GRADING, SOIL EROSION, AND SEDIMENT CONTROL, OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF HONOLULU, 1969, AS AMENDED (ORDINANCE NOS. 3968, 4294, AND 4538).
- 2. ALL SLOPES AND EXPOSED AREAS SHALL BE SODDED OR PLANTED IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE GRADING WORK HAS BEEN COMPLETED.
