GENERAL NOTES :

- 1. Improvements consist of grading, paving, constructing drainage systems, installing traffic signal systems, sidewalk, highway lighting, traffic signs, pavement markers and striping, adjusting water, sewer, electric and telephone facilities and renovating the Ilima Intermediate School band storage room.
- 2. - 5. Contractors bidding on this project shall verify the existing features at his own discretion prior to submitting a bid.
- 6. Excavation, relocation of mailboxes and fences and any other work which is required to complete the driveway adjustments, but which is not paid for separately, will be considered incidental to Asphalt Concrete Mix No.
