A compact disc containing the plans, specifications, proposal and contract forms may be obtained from the above office. Bids (hard copies) shall be submitted in a sealed envelope, and shall be on the Proposal Form provided on the compact disc furnished by said Department. Bids received after the established due date and time will not be considered.

The project includes demolition of the existing South Punaluu Stream Bridge, constructing diversion road and temporary bridge, constructing new bridge and approach roadway; traffic control; installing end post and end treatment; replacing signage and striping; stabilizing stream bank; replacing existing light standard and utilities. Estimated construction cost is over \$15,000,000 .

To be eligible for award, bidders must possess a valid State of Hawaii General Engineering Contractor's "A" license prior to the award of the contract.

A pre-bid conference is set for 9:30 A.M., June 15, 2009, at the Department of Transportation, Highways Division, Oahu District Office Conference Room, 727 Kakoi Street, Honolulu, Hawaii. All prospective bidders or their representatives (employees) are encouraged to attend, but attendance is not mandatory.

Campaign contributions by State and County Contractors. Contractors are hereby notified of the applicability of Section 11-205.5, HRS, which states that campaign contributions are prohibited from specified State or county government contractors during the term of the contract if the contractors are paid with funds appropriated by the legislative body. discrimination on the grounds of race, color, national origin and sex (as directed by 23 CFR Part 200).

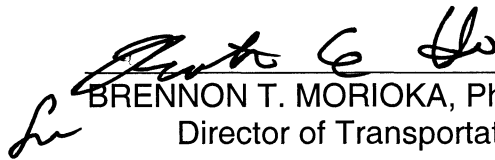
