

## **NOTICE TO BIDDERS**

(Chapter 103D, HRS)

The receiving of SEALED BIDS for KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY DRAINAGE AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS, VICINITY OF LANIAKEA BEACH (MP 3.06 TO MP 3.54), DISTRICT OF WAIALUA, ISLAND OF OAHU, PROJECT NO. 83B-01-09 will begin as advertised on HiePRO. Bidders are to register and submit bids through HiePRO only. See the following HiePRO link for important information on registering: <https://hiepro.ehawaii.gov/welcome.html>.

Deadline to submit bids is **HEREBY RE-SCHEDULED** for **SEPTEMBER 28, 2023, at 2:00 p.m. Hawaii Standard Time (HST)**. Bidders shall submit and **upload the complete proposal to HiePRO** prior to the bid opening date and time. Proposals received after said due date and time shall not be considered. Any additional support documents explicitly designated as **confidential and/or proprietary** shall be uploaded as a **separate file** to HiePRO. Do not include confidential and/or proprietary documents with the proposal. The record of each bidder and respective bid shall be open to public inspection. **FAILURE TO UPLOAD THE PROPOSAL TO HiePRO SHALL BE GROUNDS FOR REJECTION OF THE BID.**

Plans, specifications, proposal, contract forms and permit documents such as the Notice of Intent (NOI), Notice of General Permit Coverage (NGPC), Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP), Section 401 Application, and Water Quality Certification (WQC) are available on HiePRO.

The project scope of work consists of realigning Kamehameha Highway in the vicinity of Lauhulu Stream Bridge and Pohakuloa Way. The project includes the construction of AC pavement; removing existing pavement, two span bridge, wingwalls, dump riprap, temporary water line relocation, concrete approach slab, concrete cutoff wall, guardrails, installation and relocation of fencing, drainage system, street lighting, landscaping, geotextiles, signs and pavement markings, adjusting and relocating utilities, cold planing; erosion control; and traffic control. The estimated cost of construction is between \$15,000,000 and \$20,000,000.

To be eligible for award, bidders must possess a valid State of Hawaii General Engineering "A" license at the time of bidding.

A pre-bid conference is scheduled for 9:00 A.M., August 1, 2023. All prospective bidders or their representatives (employees) are encouraged to attend, but attendance is not mandatory.

All Request for Information (RFI) questions and substitution requests shall be submitted to the Project Manager **no later than fourteen (14) calendar days** before bid opening. RFI questions received after the stated deadline will not be addressed. Verbal RFIs will not receive a response. All responses to RFI questions shall be issued by formal addendum and posted in HlePRO.

Hawaii Products Preference. In accordance with ACT 174, SLH 2022, effective June 27, 2022, Hawaii Products Preference shall not apply to solicitations for public works construction. Therefore, the Hawaii Products Preference shall not apply to this project.

Apprenticeship Preference. A 5% bid adjustment for bidders that are party to apprenticeship agreements pursuant to §103-55.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), is applicable to this project.

Employment of State Residents on Construction Procurement Contracts. Compliance with §103B-3, HRS, is a requirement for this project whereby a minimum of 80% of the bidder's work force on this project shall consist of Hawaii residents.

Protests. Any protest of this solicitation shall be submitted in writing to the Director of Transportation, in accordance with §103D-701, HRS, and §3-126, Hawaii Administrative Rules.

Campaign contributions by State and County Contractors. Contractors are hereby notified of the applicability of Section 11-355, HRS, which states that campaign contributions are prohibited from specified State or county government contractors during the term of the contract if the contractors are paid with funds appropriated by a legislative body. The Equal Employment Opportunity Regulations of the Secretary of Labor implementing Executive Order 11246, as amended, shall be complied with on this project.

Driving While Impaired (DWI) Education. HDOT encourages all organizations contracted with the DOT to have an employee education program preventing DWI. DWI is defined as operating a motor vehicle while impaired by alcohol or other legal or illegal substances. HDOT promotes this type of program to accomplish our mission to provide a safe environment for motorists, bicyclists and pedestrians utilizing our State highways, and expects its contractors to do so as well.
