

STREET TREE NOTES

- 1. The contractor shall notify the Beautification Administrator, Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR), phone 971—7151 at least seven (7) days prior to pre—maintenance and final inspections. Contractor shall submit two sets of plans to DPR for pre—maintenance and final inspections.
- 2. Maintenance of street trees shall be for nine (9) months or until project maintenance has been assumed by abutting property owner.
- 3. The Standard City and County of Honolulu, Department of Planning and Permitting Specifications for street tree planting and landscaping shall be made part of the construction documents.
- 4. Street Tree plans that have been revised or haven't started construction within two (2) years of the date of the Urban Design Branch Chief's approval will be subject to re—approval.
- 5. When substitution of tree types are requested by the developer or contractor due to unavailability, the plans shall be revised after notification of tree selection and the plans submitted for re—approval.
- 6. Final "As-Built" tracings reflecting all actual conditions will be prepared by the City and filed with the Department of Planning and Permitting. The Contractor along with the Engineer / Inspector shall note all changes and deviations on a set of plans immediately following notice of Acceptance (Project Completion Notice) of the street tree planting to facilitate the transfer of information onto the tracings. (Attention: Chief, Urban Design Branch).
- 7. Approval is for Street Tree planting within the road right—of—way only. It is not an approval of the planting and irrigation plan outside of the road right—of—way.
- 8. The Community Association, homeowner or lot owner is responsible to pay for water and electricity and provide maintenance for the street trees within the road right—of—ways abutting their properties.

PLANT NOTES:

- Landscape Contractor shall field verify all plant quantities and dimensions prior to installation. Quantities shown in Plant List are for convenience only. Plans shall govern.
- 2. Landscape Contractor shall be responsible for locating and protecting all existing utilities.
- 3. Notify and meet with the Engineer prior to plant installation for verification/interpretation of plans.
- 4. Notify Engineer of any discrepancies in plant locations or insufficient plant quantities due to differences in plan and actual field conditions.
- 5. Notify Engineer 30 days prior to planting operations for approval of all plant material at place of growth. All plant material not approved by the Engineer will be subject to rejection.
- 6. The Landscape Contractor shall stake out tree locations prior to installation for approval by the Engineer. Notify Engineer (5) working days in advance.
- 7. Landscape Contractor shall provide temporary irrigation for street trees during establishment and maintenance period. If above grade temporary irrigation is used, the Landscape Contractor shall remove the temporary irrigation system at the end of the maintenance period.


