

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1 Make the following Section a part of the Standard Specifications:

3 **"SECTION 212 – ARCHAEOLOGICAL MONITORING**

4  
5 **212.01 Description.** This work includes the monitoring of construction activities  
6 for archaeological items and complying with other requirements of the  
7 Archaeological Monitoring Plan for the project.

8  
9 **212.02 Materials.** None

10  
11 **212.03 Construction Requirements.** An approved Archaeological Monitoring  
12 plan is on file with the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State Historic  
13 Preservation Division (SHPD). A copy of the plan is included in the bid document  
14 CD. The Contractor shall adhere to the conditions of this monitoring plan as well as  
15 comply with the requirements of Section 107.13(B) – Archaeological, Historical, and  
16 Burial Sites.

17  
18 The Contractor shall obtain the services of a qualified Archaeologist or  
19 firm to monitor all ground altering disturbance work such as clearing and grubbing,  
20 excavation, and trenching activities for historical remains such as artifacts, burials,  
21 concentration of shells or charcoal, and to fulfill the other requirements of the  
22 monitoring plan.

24 A list of qualified Archaeologist or Archaeological firms meeting the  
25 requirements to perform the required work of this contract can be obtained from the  
26 SHPD website at <http://dlnr.hawaii.gov/shpd/files/2015/07/2015-Permittee-List-6.pdf>.

27  
28 If remains are found, work shall cease in the immediate vicinity of the find  
29 and the find shall be protected from further damage. The Archaeologist shall  
30 immediately contact the State Historic Preservation Division (808) 692-8023, which  
31 will assess the significance of the find and recommend appropriate mitigation  
32 measures, if necessary.

33  
34 The Contractor shall submit to the Engineer a copy of the qualified  
35 Archaeological firm's valid Archaeological permit prior to the Notice to Proceed date.  
36 Additionally, the Contractor shall submit to the Engineer a copy of the qualified  
37 Archaeological firm's valid Archaeological permit every subsequent calendar year by  
38 the first working day in January of that calendar year.

39  
40 **212.04 Measurement.** The Engineer will measure archaeological monitoring,  
41 including remedial measures to document and/or preserve finds, on a force account  
42 basis, in accordance with Subsection 109.06 – Force Account Provisions and  
43 Compensation.

44  
45 **212.05 Payment.** The Engineer will pay for the accepted archaeological  
46 monitoring by a qualified archaeologist or firm, including necessary remedial  
47 measures on a force account basis in accordance with Subsection 109.06 – Force  
48 Account Provisions and Compensation. Payment will be full compensation for work

prescribed in this section, the Archaeological Monitoring plan, and the contract documents.

The Engineer will pay for the following pay item when included in the proposal schedule:

| Pay Item                  | Pay Unit      |

| Archaeological Monitoring | Force Account |

An estimated amount for the force account may be allocated in the proposal schedule under "Archaeological Monitoring", but the actual amount to be paid will be the sum shown on the accepted force account records, whether the sum be more or less than the estimated amount allocated in the proposal schedule.

The Engineer will not pay for work required that is due to the Contractor's convenience, negligence, carelessness or failure to properly monitor the work."
