The following RFI/questions were submitted via HlePRO by prospective bidders as of December 15, 2021. The questions and responses are as follows:

1. With reference to Special Provision page 107-3a, rows #122-131, and considering the work involved with this project please confirm or clarify the requirement for Builders Risk Insurance for this project.

Response: Required according to the specifications.

2. What is the working hours?

Response: See Note #22 on sheet 4 of the Construction Plans and Standard Specifications Section 645 – Work Zone Traffic Control (Page 645-6).

3. Is the construction sign required?

Response: The begin and End Work Zone signs are required. This will be included in the addendum.

4. Is the site temporary office required?

Response: Force account intended to assist maintenance of existing State owned trailers.

5. Builder's risk insurance required?

Response: Required according to the specifications.

6. There is a line item for maintenance of trailers in the proposal. Item # 696.0100. Who will be providing the trailers? Will DOT bring their own, or does need to be included in our bid proposal?

Response: Force account intended to assist maintenance of existing State owned trailers.
