



TEMPORARY PORTABLE CONCRETE BARRIER PLAN




PORTABLE CONCRETE BARRIER POSITION DETAIL FOR WIDENING WORK

Notes:

1. Portable Concrete Barrier End Treatment System shall comply with and be installed per the manufacturer's recommendations/requirements and shall be paid under Contract Item No. 695.2000 - End Treatment Module.
2. Place Type II Barricade w/Lamp at spacings and positions that comply with part 6 of the MUTCD, Typical Application 5, and install steady burn amber lamps on Portable Concrete Barriers @ 20.0' o.c. Installing, maintaining and removing each steady burn amber lamp including changing of batteries and bulbs shall be considered incidental to Contract Item No. 695.1000 - State-Furnished Portable Concrete Barrier.
3. See Special Provisions Section 695 - Portable Concrete Barrier and End Treatment System.
4. Travel Lanes shall be temporarily restriped and adjusted to a minimum of 10 feet to accommodate Portable Concrete Barrier Installation and use. Following the completion of road widening work, Travel Lanes shall be striped according to the traffic plans. This work shall be considered incidental to Contract Item No. 695.1000 - Portable Concrete Barrier (State Furnished) and shall not be paid for separately.
5. The Contractor shall develop a Traffic Control Plan to include all necessary Traffic Control Devices. This work shall be considered incidental to Contract Item No. 645.0100 - Traffic Control and shall not be paid for separately.
