Bids (hard copies) shall be submitted in a sealed envelope, and shall be on the Proposal Form provided on the compact disc furnished by said Department. Bids received after the established due date and time will not be considered.

The project includes installation of permanent BMP structures, installation of cement rubble masonry walls and concrete structures; planting; retrofit of existing drainage structures; installation and maintenance of erosion control BMP's; and providing traffic control. Estimated construction cost is between \$400,000 and \$500,000.

To be eligible to bid, bidders must possess a valid State of Hawaii General Engineering Contractor's "A" license, prior to bidding.

The Hawaii Products Preference pursuant to Act 175, SLH 2009, is applicable to this project. Persons wishing to certify and qualify a product as a Hawaii Product shall submit a Certification for Hawaii Product Preference (SPO- Form 38) to the DOT Contracts office no later than 4:30 P.M., fourteen (14) calendar days prior to the bid opening date. Late submittals for this project will not be reviewed by the DOT. A separate SPO-Form 38 shall be completed and submitted for each product. Forms are available at http://www4.hawaii.gov/StateForms/ShowForm.cfm.

A 5% bid adjustment for bidders that are parties to apprenticeship agreements pursuant to Section 103-55.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), is applicable to this project.

Compliance with Act 192, SLH 2011 is a requirement whereby a minimum of 80% of the bidder's work force on this project **must** consist of Hawaii residents.

A pre-bid conference is set for May 29, 2014, at the Department of Transportation, Highways Division – Kakuhihewa Building, 601 Kamokila Blvd, Room 609, Kapolei. All prospective bidders or their representatives (employees) are encouraged to attend, but attendance is not mandatory.
